I support ending "sanctuary city" policies in Texas which includes the withholding of state funds from units of local government that refuse to cooperate with the federal Immigration & Customs Enforcement agency in enforcing U.S. immigration laws

I support requiring all state agencies to report the cost of benefits and services provided to illegal aliens in Texas.

I support repealing the TX law which granted illegal aliens in-state tuition privileges at state colleges and universities.

I support Photo Voter ID.

I believe that we should secure our border by using physical fencing, surveillance, National Guard Training exercises near the border, and the use of Texas Rangers, etc.

Additional Comments

I believe that the most effective way to stem the tide of illegal aliens entering Texas is to remove the benefits for these individuals. However, there are three items not listed above that I have included as part of my platform. My "platform" consists of public statements, postcards, and push cards.

1. We need to make English the official language of Texas. Creating an environment where government documents are in other languages is (1) expensive, (2) detrimental to immigrants and (3) facilitates the ability of illegal aliens to live in Texas.
2. Oppose Bi-lingual education. This expensive and ineffective politically correct tool needs to be stopped. On my first day of kindergarten I spoke two languages, Italian and Spanish. There was no diversity training, or bi-lingual education. So....by the end of kindergarten, I spoke three languages!
